2007

- Tied her career-best finish at the Sybase Classic presented by ShopRite, where she finished second.
- Recorded six additional top-10 finishes, including a third-place finish at the Michelob ULTRA Open at Kingsmill, where she carded a season-low 63 (-8) in the opening round and the season-low 18-hole score on Tour for a par-71 course; tied for fourth at the Ginn Tribute Hosted by ANNIKA.
- Tied a Tour-record for low nine-hole score in relation to par with a 28 (-8) on the front nine during the second round of the Corona Championship.
- Recorded her second LPGA career hole-in-one in the final round of the Samsung World Championship, where she tied for 10th.

Career

- In 2006, recorded a career-best second at the Safeway International Presented by Coca-Cola, where she recorded her first LPGA career hole-in-one in the opening round; crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings with a tie for 10th at the Longs Drugs Challenge.
- In 2005, best finish was a tie for 16th at the Corona Morelia Championship; did not compete in August or September due to a left thumb injury.
- In 2004, opened the year with a career-low 60 at the Welch's/Fry's Championship, the second-lowest score and the lowest first-round score in LPGA history, and eventually tied for second; also tied for second at the Chick-fil-A Charity Championship hosted by Nancy Lopez.
- In 2003, best finish was a tie for second at the Longs Drugs Challenge.
- In 2002, best finish was fifth place at the LPGA Corning Classic.
- In 2001, while competing on the Futures Tour, recorded nine top-10 finishes in 19 tournaments, including back-to-back wins at the Innerform Golf Challenge and Futures Golf Classic at Green Mountain National; finished third on the Futures Tour money list to earn exempt status for the 2002 LPGA season.
- From 1998-2001, competed on the Korean LPGA, where she won the 1999 SBS Championship.
- In September 1998, turned professional.

Amateur

As an amateur, Lee won the Sports Chosun Middle/High School Cup and finished third at the Korean Girls Amateur Championship and the College Association Choice Cup.
